

Workplaces in the library for Masters students

Students at Lucerne university and teacher training college who are writing up their **Masters dissertations** now have access to 25 peaceful and reserved workplaces in the 1st. A04 (study room for doctoral students, 1st floor, library) which are subject to the following **terms and conditions of use**:

- For study purposes, books, journals and other media from the library can be taken into the study room for doctoral students. At the end of the day, unless these materials have been borrowed for home use, they must be placed on the book trolley provided by the library to enable everything to be returned to its proper location. These workplaces are not assigned to specific individuals, and must be left empty by the men and women students whenever they leave the library.
- In each case, these workplaces can be used for ten months from the date of issue of the parking ticket (issued by the Information desk). Earlier return of the parking ticket is possible at any time. There is no scope for extending the period of use. If capacities are not exhausted, a new application can be made after the parking ticket has been returned. The right to use the workplace can be revoked with immediate effect in the event of any infringement of the terms and conditions of use, or of the Code of Conduct or the House Rules.
- All men and women using these facilities are liable for any damage they may cause. The provisions of the Code of Conduct and the House Rules apply.
